



Associate Teacher Additional Qualifications Course

ONLINE! Nipissing University is planning to provide "The Associate Teacher" Additional Qualification course through on-line delivery during the Fall/Winter Session.

To enroll in the course, you must be an associate teacher and commit to hosting a pre-service teacher for at least three or four consecutive weeks during the session in which the course is held.

The associate teacher plays an essential role in preparing pre-service teachers to enter the profession. The course, which requires a minimum of 125 hours of work by the candidate, includes eight modules, three of which are completed during the practicum. Flexibility is built into the ordering of the modules because candidates will have pre-service teachers at different times within the session. Since this is an on-line course, you are expected to have a basic proficiency working with computer technology, Internet searching, web page navigation (including downloading, uploading, and printing files) and e-mail use (sending and receiving attachments).

The course is based on Nipissing University's practice teaching requirements and resources. However, candidates who are associate teachers for other universities may discuss with the instructor how to substitute the requirements and resources of their university. Nipissing University associate teachers who have tuition credit vouchers may use them for this course.
