



## Website or e-Portfolio Experience

**Value:** 15%



### **Expectations:**

- All pre-service teachers will have the opportunity to explore the process of constructing a website and/or e-Portfolio for educational purposes
- Students will have the freedom to select a method of their choice for constructing the website
  - [www.teacherweb.com](http://www.teacherweb.com), iWeb, Adobe Dreamweaver, Microsoft SharePoint or FrontPage, Manual HTML code, other simplified webpage construction software (e.g., MS Publisher, MS Word, MS PowerPoint, Yahoo Website Creator, etc.)
- Students may choose to create an e-Portfolio to profile themselves as a new teacher candidate in place of the traditional website
- Students may submit a website which was created for another Nipissing Education course
- Students may choose to post their website on-line or copy to a CD or iTeach USB Memory Stick so Professor Waller has access to view the content

**Content:** The content of the website and/or e-Portfolio is the responsibility of the pre-service teacher. Whatever they deem appropriate to demonstrate their abilities as an educator in the area of webpage creation. The subject matter must be connected to “education” and not some irrelevant topic (Hockey Pool, Personal Hobby Blog, etc.).

### **What to Submit:**

1. URL address which links to your website  
OR  
Copy of the website files on a CD or saved to one of the iTeach USB Memory Sticks
2. Complete an on-line survey which will provide an opportunity for the pre-service teacher to profile their website construction experience. Questions address such areas as:
  - a. What tool(s) did you select to create your website? Why did you select those tools?
  - b. How do you feel about the concept of creating and using a website in your future classroom? How would you potentially use the site to support your classroom needs?
