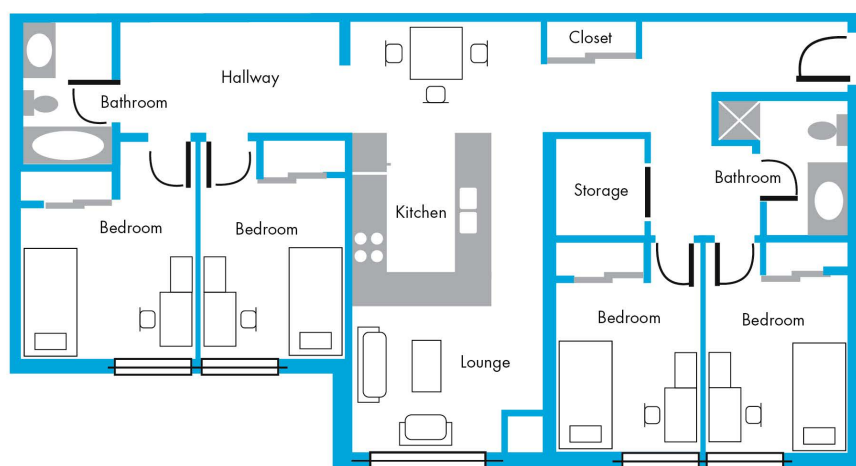

Residence Complexes

North Bay Campus has three suite styled residences – Founders House, Chancellors House and Governors House. Founders and Chancellors Houses are located at the bottom of the College Drive hill and are close to coffee shops, grocery, drug and convenience stores. It's a short walk or a three-minute bus ride from these residences to your classes. Governors House is located across from the athletics facilities, at the top of the hill.

Furnished suites accommodate four students. Each student has their own private bedroom and access to a shared kitchen with fridge and stove, a living room and two full bathrooms.

Reduced Residence Rates

Nipissing University offers reduced residence fees for students entering the 2-Year Consecutive Bachelor of Education (BEd) Program in September 2021. Eligible students will receive the reduced rate to reflect the Bachelor of Education year 2 schedule in which classes conclude in February – a savings of about \$1630.

Year 1: Student pays full residence fees.
(Approximately \$6525, 2020 rates)

Year 2: Student pays 6 months of residence fees instead of the full 8 months.
(Approximately \$4890, 2020 rates)

Note: Students are required to live in residence for both first and second year of the program in order to be eligible for the second year fee reduction.

The Residence Rate Schedule is determined annually in the spring and is posted on the website as it becomes available. For current rate information, visit

Apply to Residence

Residence applications are available through Nipissing's online application for students who have received an offer of admission to the University. To access the residence application visit nipissing.erezlife.com/login

The first time you visit the online application, you will be required to create an account. To create an account, you will need to enter the email address that you provided on your TEAS application and the last six digits of your Nipissing University student ID number. A temporary password will be sent to your email address.

Important Dates

June 1, 2021 – To be considered in our first round of placements you must submit your application and pay your \$400 residence deposit.

August – In early August, applicants will receive their residence assignment package from the Residence Admissions Office via email.
