SOCIOLOGY 4096 Honours Thesis Proposal

Students entering the fourth year of the Honours Sociology program, and who are interested in pursuing graduate school or a professional program, may benefit by enrolling in SOCIOLOGY 4096 Honours Thesis Proposal. This course is restricted to students in the fourth year of the Honours Sociology Program, the completion of 36 credits in Sociology, and the approval of the Department prior to registration.

To fulfill the requirements of SOCIOLOGY 4096 Honours Thesis Proposal, the student must design and submit a completed research project to be undertaken in SOCIOLOGY 4097 Honours Thesis. Various forms of research, e.g., surveys, interviews, theoretical enquiries, secondary analyses of existing data or studies may be proposed. A final grade of 75% is required in SOCIOLOGY 4096 in order to enroll in SOCIOLOGY 4097 Honours Thesis.

SOCIOLOGY 4096 Honours Thesis Proposal requires the supervision of a faculty member of the Sociology department. Written work, periodic discussions, and a final research proposal are required.
