



***Nipissing University Alumni Advisory Board
Dr. James Jamieson Influential Alumni Award***

PURPOSE:

- **Presented to an alumnus/ae whose dedication and leadership has influenced significant change and prosperity within their community.**
- **The recipient may be an alumnus of one of the following institutions: North Bay Normal School, Teacher's College, Nipissing University College or Nipissing University.**

The award is named after Dr. James Jamieson, who was made an honorary member of the Nipissing University Alumni Association in the early 1980s. He was one of the founding members of the Alumni Association and served as its first President from 1973 - 1975. He served as a member of the Board of Governors from 1975 - 1986. In 1981, he, along with Dr. George Zytaruk, was instrumental in the setting up of the Office of Alumni Affairs.

The award will be presented during the annual Alumni Awards event.

NOTE: Alumni Advisory Board Members are ineligible to receive an award during their time of service. However, nominations may still be submitted and will be held for future consideration.

Nominators are not allowed to be related to the nominee.

THE AWARD WILL CONSIST OF:

1. A framed certificate.
2. A photo in the Alumni e-Newsletter and/or a press release to the local paper.
3. Winner's name to be displayed on the Alumni Awards wall.
4. Highlighted on our Alumni website.

NOMINATIONS:

Nomination (application) forms must be signed by the nominator and include:

- the name of the nominee
- identification of the field of endeavour for which the Nominee is being chosen
- a 200 word summary from the Nominator explaining how the nominee meets the criteria for this award
- complete biography or C.V. (including degrees and honours previously bestowed by Nipissing or other bodies)
- professional and volunteer positions held by candidate)
- three (3) reference letters: professional, personal and community references encouraged
- notable achievements in other fields of endeavour
- description of how they represent Nipissing University
- other information deemed helpful to the selection committee

All information should be presented in a concise form and be suitable for duplication so the entire submission can be distributed to members of the selection committee.

Nominations will be accepted at the Office of Advancement at any time of the year. The Alumni Coordinator will notify award winners of the decision.
