



Declaration of Intention to Complete Vulnerable Records Check

The Youth Criminal Justice Act (YJCA) and the Police Record Check Reform Act (PRCRA) implemented in November 2018 prevents disclosure of criminal records for youth under the age of 18. Students who are enrolled in the School of Nursing at Nipissing University may have contact with vulnerable persons and as such are required to complete their Vulnerable Sector Checks as soon as possible.

The School of Nursing will require that all students request and submit a completed Police Vulnerable Sector Check (PVSC) to the clearance website within six weeks of their 18th birthday. Failure to complete and submit a Vulnerable Sector Check within the timeline outlined will result in a students' immediate removal from the clinical setting which will result is a loss of clinical time which cannot be recovered.

Declaration

I have read and understand that I am responsible for requesting and submitting a completed Police Vulnerable Sector Check within six weeks of turning 18. I understand and accept that my failure to complete my Police Vulnerable Sector Check within the timeframe as outlined may result in my removal from the clinical setting and potentially receiving a U (unsatisfactory) grade in Clinical Practicum.

I understand the implications and accept responsibility for submitting a completed Police Vulnerable Sector Check within the time frame as outlined to meet program requirements.
