Note about Electives. You can choose any course, as an elective course, as long as it is not a core program course. Courses that do not have an 881 code will require you to book exams at a local exam centre, or write the exam in North Bay. **Due to Covid-19, for the fall semester 2020, there will NOT be any in-class sections (822) or CPP codes (881, 882). Please choose either online (801) or synchronous online (841) codes.**

BComm (4-year) students: Ensure 6-credits (2 courses) of your electives are selected from business courses and are at the 4000 level.

When you register for courses at Nipissing University, the code and location you choose will determine:

- The **type of course delivery** (in-class, synchronous online or online) and the **location** (Centennial distance)
- **Where** you will write your final exam (Centennial or North Bay*)

The “term” refers to the semester and academic year

- 20FW- Fall (FA), Winter (WI), SS21- Spring/Summer registration opens in February 2021.

*As a default, all **distance courses** are scheduled to be written in North Bay. These are courses with codes 801/802/803 etc. or 841/842/843 etc. For most people, writing their exams in North Bay is not convenient. You may choose to write your distance exam at a local exam center which **you** will arrange in accordance with deadline dates set by the Registrar’s office. *Distance Exam request form:* <https://www.nipissingu.ca/departments/admissions-registrar/application-and-other-forms>. **Please note, due to Covid-19, for the FALL 2020 semester, there will be no written face-to-face exams. All exams for the fall semester will be written by secured locked down browser (online). We hope to revert back to a regular written face-to-face exam in the winter semester.**

As a CPP ‘Centennial’ student, if you choose the following codes, Nipissing will schedule your exams at Centennial. Every attempt will be made to schedule your exams in the evening. However, due to conflicts, some exams may be written during the day.

- 881/882/883 etc. (distance and SYNC courses)
- 822 (in-class/blended)
