ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Completion of a minimum of 18 credits of undergraduate study at Nipissing University, and no more than 72 university credits (including transferred credits).
- A minimum overall average of 75% on all university courses completed.
- Completion of a 3U, 3M OR 4U Mathematics (or equivalent) with a minimum 60% or a university or college level Mathematics (not Academic and Career Entrance (ACE) Program courses or Statistics) with a minimum grade of 60%

Note: If you are adding Concurrent Education to your current program you must be eligible to continue in your program for admission consideration. If you are also switching your undergraduate degree program you must be admissible to that program in order to be given admission consideration to Concurrent Education.

Protection of Privacy
