Section 1: Eligibility

The Dean, Graduate Studies and Research will approve delay of publication requests if there is a suitable justification, such as:

- 1. Pending patent application and copyright material that requires processing before publication
- 2. Publication in peer-reviewed journals is pending
- 3. The thesis refers to dangerous products, harmful procedures, or a hypothetical treatment for a disease which requires further testing before publication

If an extension on the delay of publication is required, the request must be filed two months prior to the new release date.
