- A typed statement of 300 words that describes the reason(s) for selecting teaching as a profession and specifically addresses your plans to serve Indigenous children and communities. Include professional experiences to support the application.

### Visible Minority Candidate

- A typed statement of 300 - 400 words describing reasons for selecting teaching as a profession. Include which visible minority group(s) you belong to; and
- Two confidential reference letters; and
- Any documentation that you feel would support your case.

### ECE, CYW, or Child Studies Candidate

- Official transcripts confirming eligibility under this category; and
- Two confidential reference letters; and
- A typed statement of 300 - 400 words describing reasons for selecting teaching as a profession.
