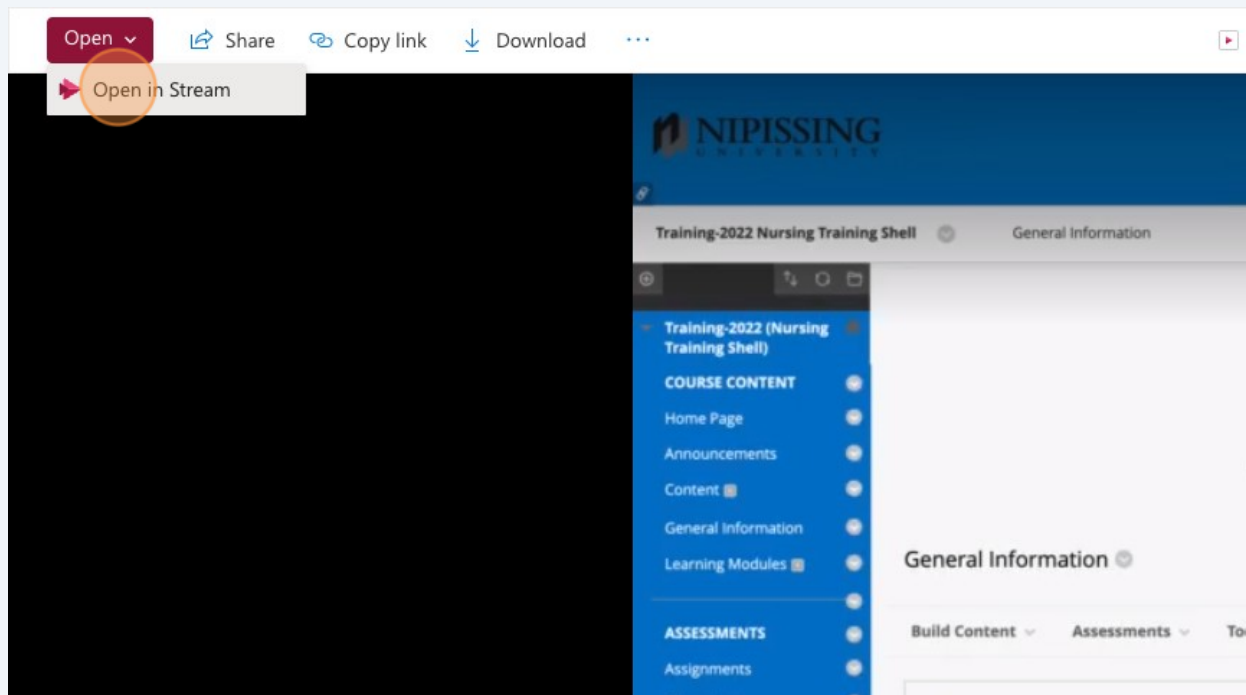

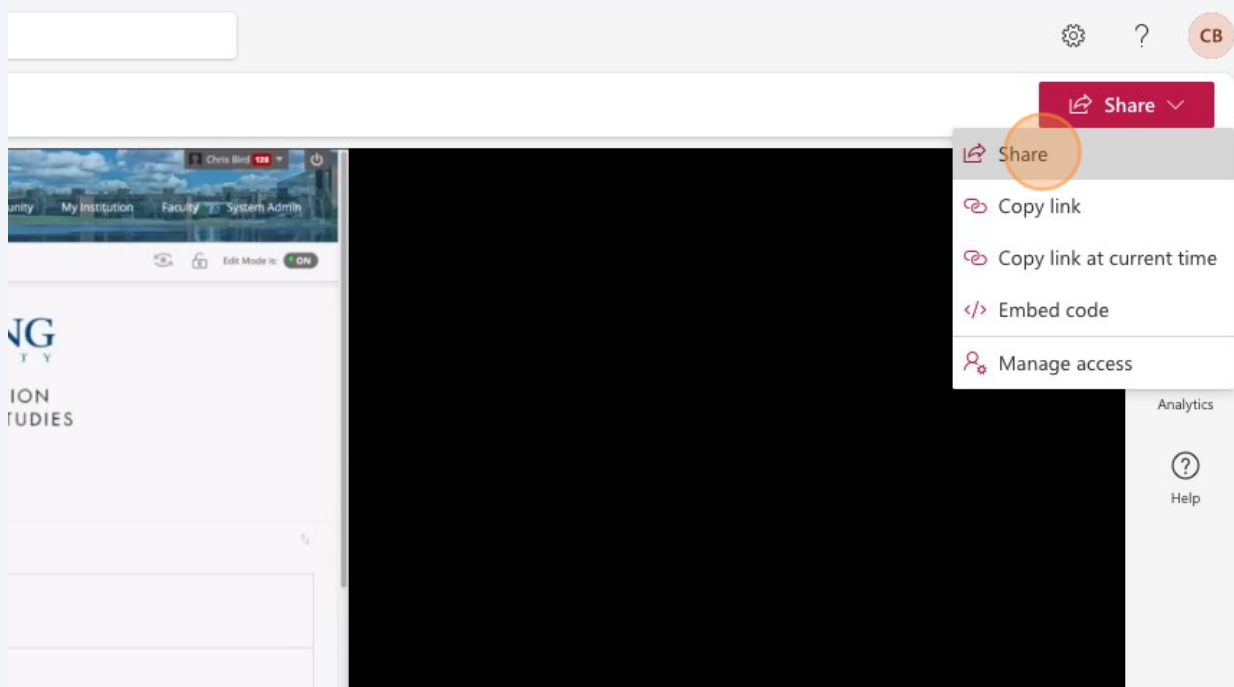

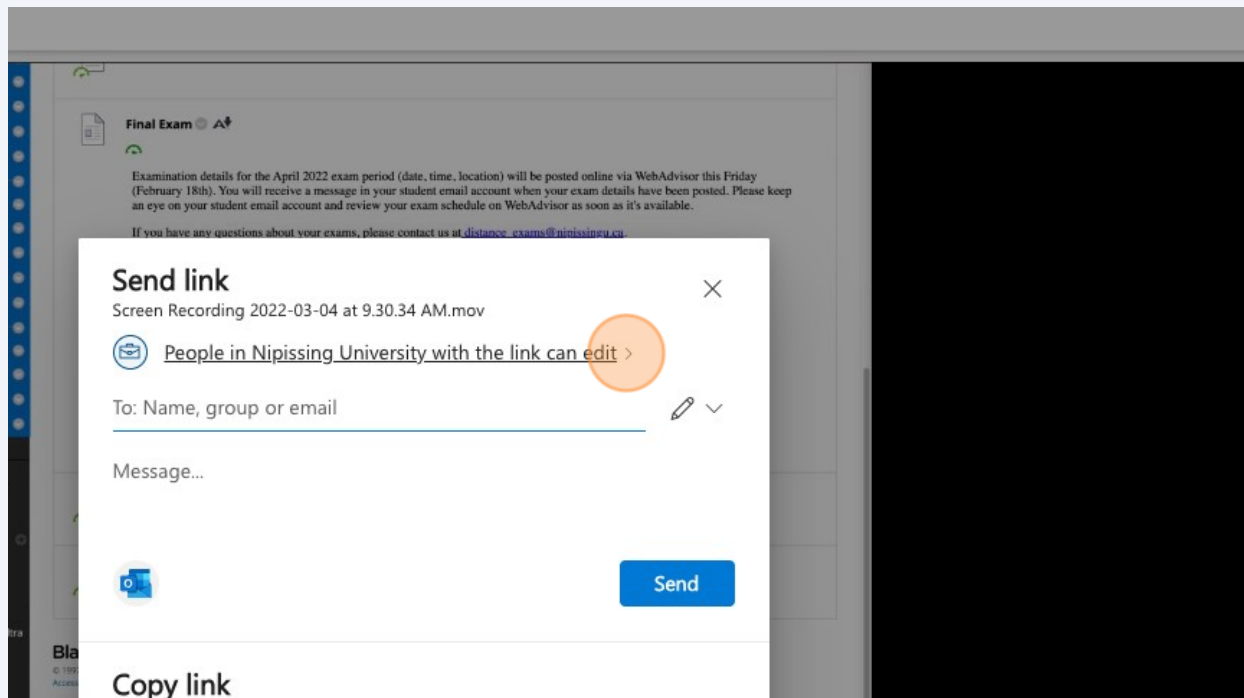
2 Select the open button, and then click 'Open in Stream'



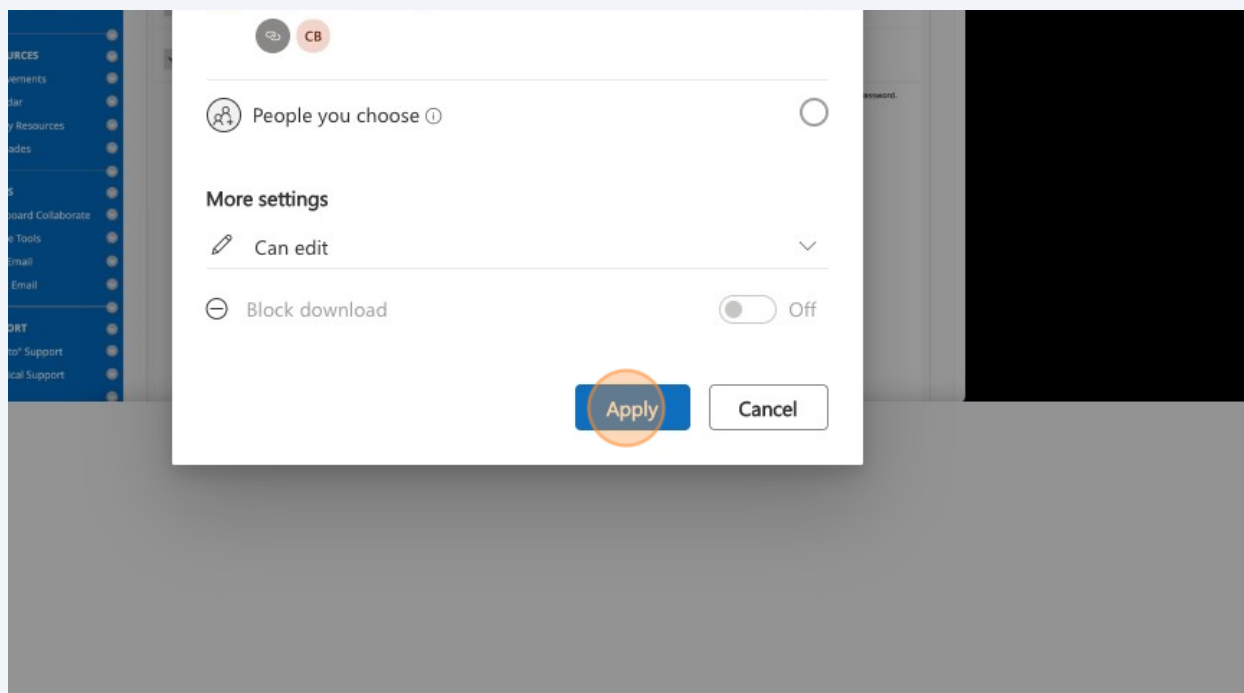
3 Click "Share" and then "Share" again.



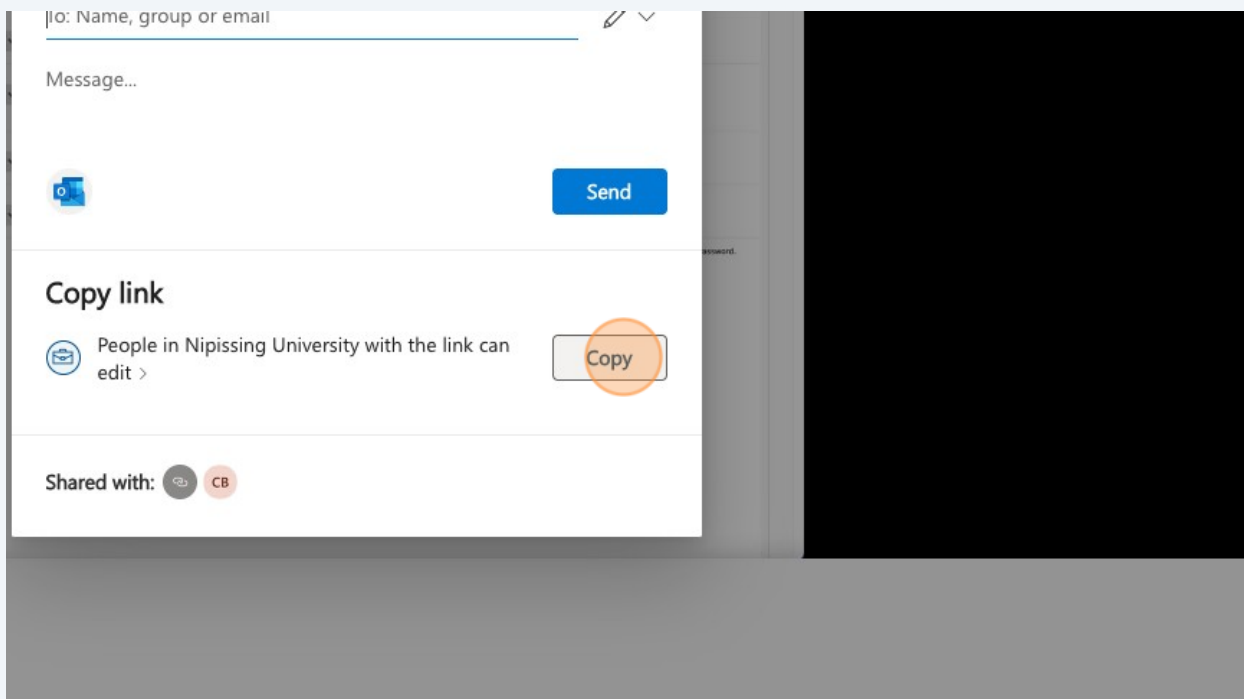
- 4 Click the chevron noted below to expand the sharing options.



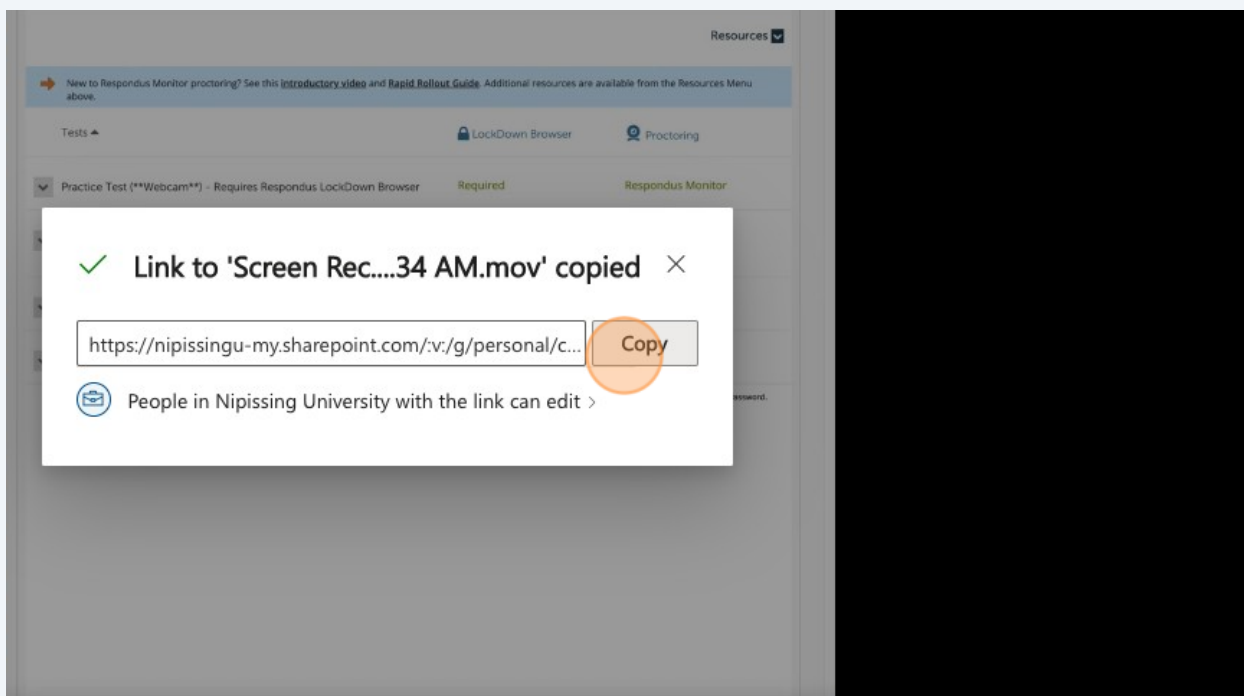
- 5 Once you've chosen how to share your file, click 'Apply'



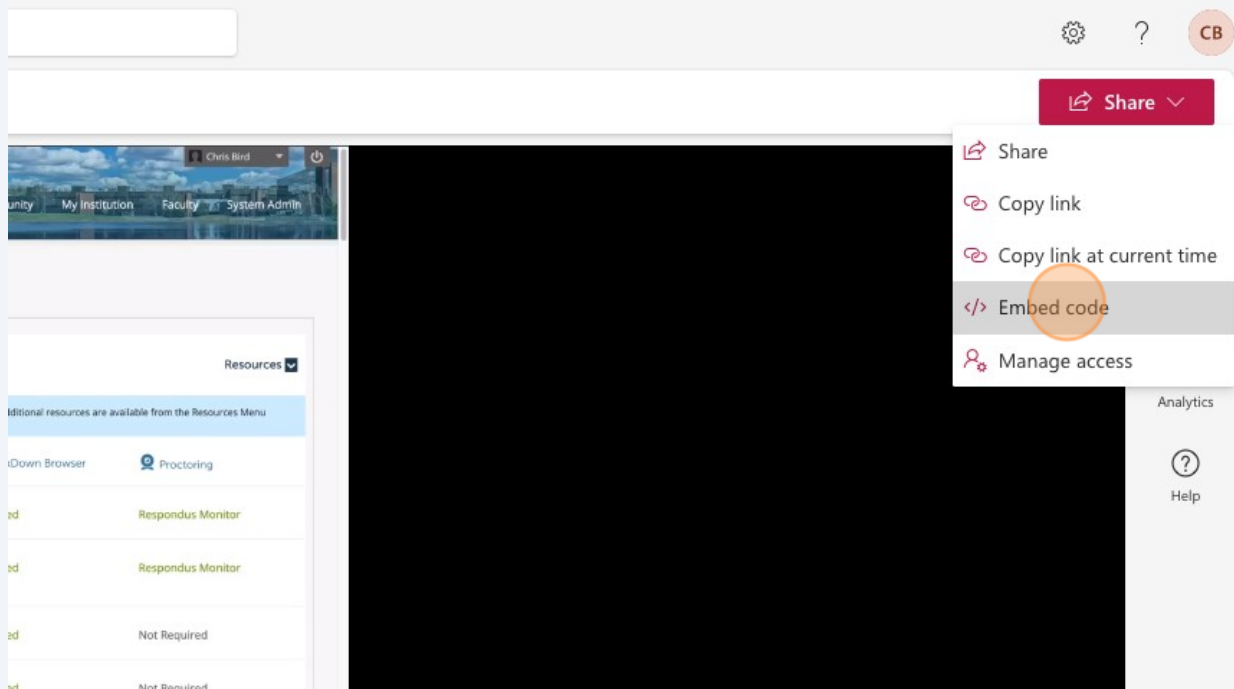
6 You can now copy and paste the link anywhere you'd like.



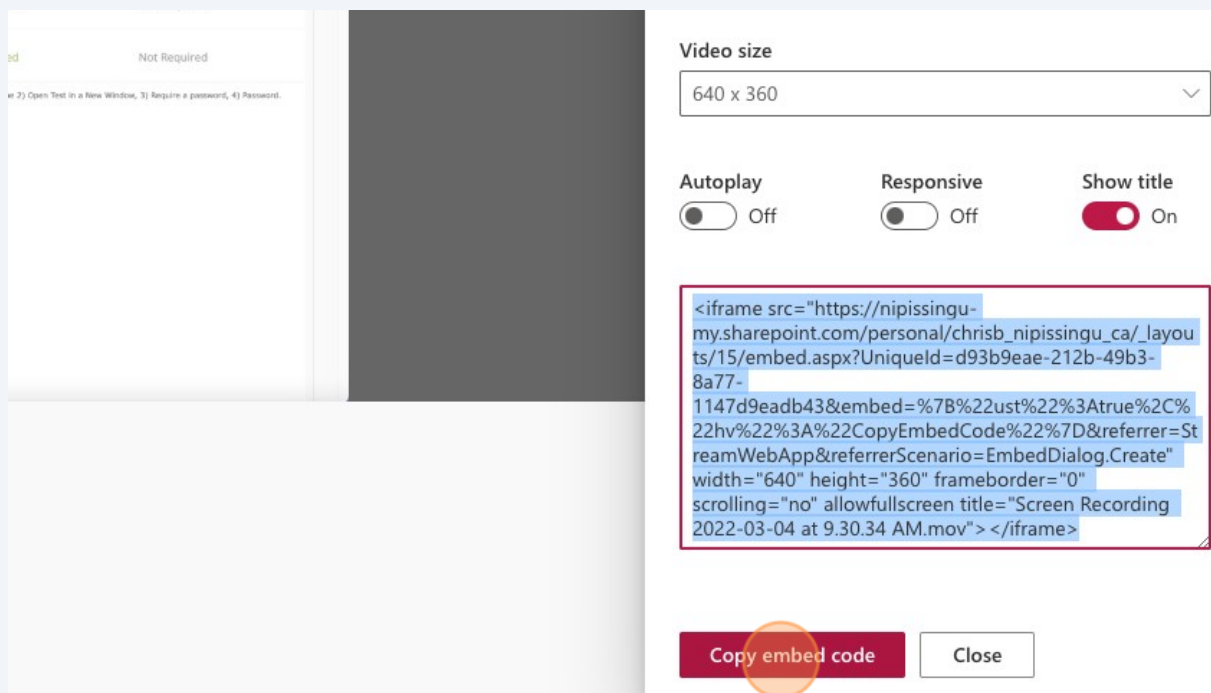
7 Click "Copy"




8 Alternately, you can click the 'Share' button, and then click "Embed code"



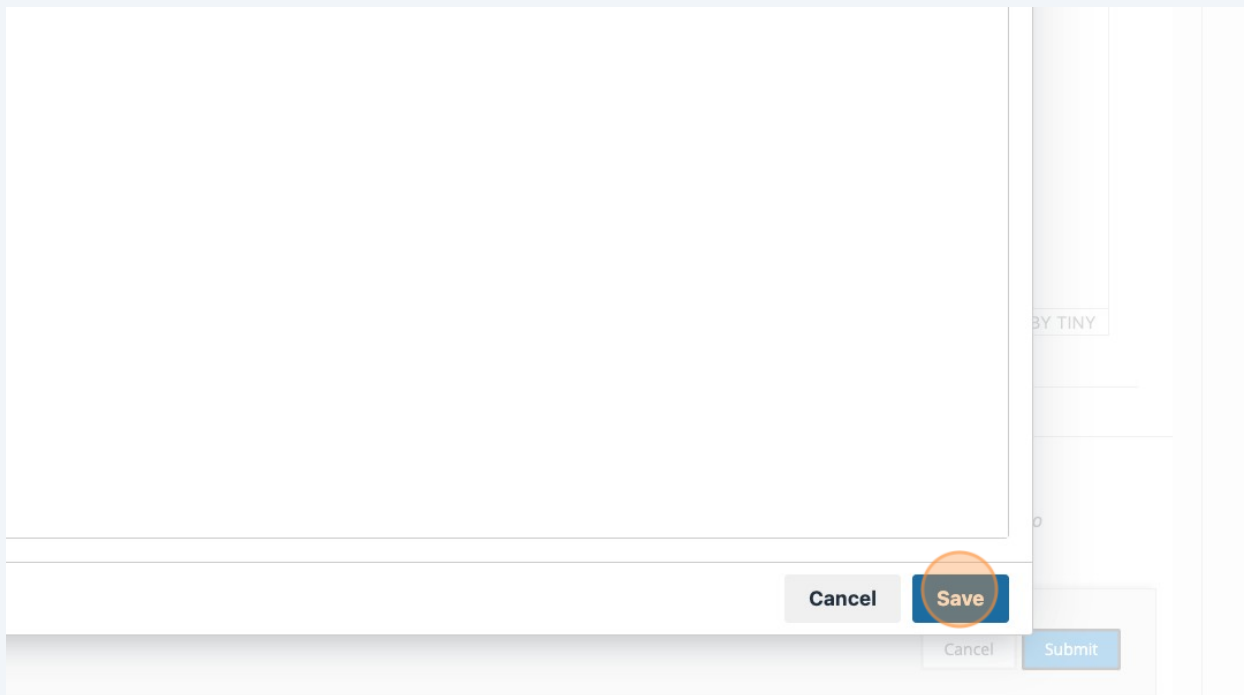

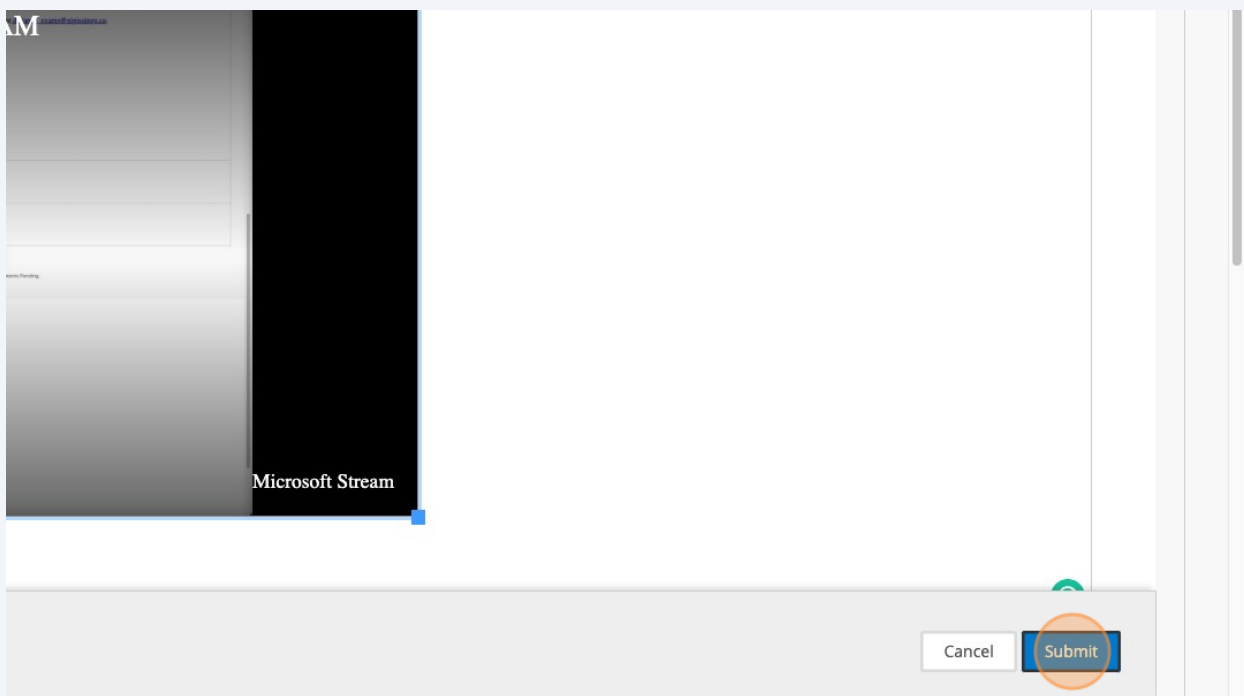
