<b>Chancellor's Awards**</b> Application form required and available at: <a href="http://nipissingu.ca/financialaid">nipissingu.ca/financialaid</a>	Awarded to two students entering full-time studies. Applicants must have a minimum 85% average and show evidence of personal leadership activities: Recipients must also demonstrate financial need and be residents of Ontario. Each recipient receives \$10,000 during their first year, and the scholarship is renewable for up to three additional years at \$3,000 per year based on the maintenance of a minimum 85% average on their best 24 credits. Apply by <b>May 1, 2026</b> .	<b>\$10,000</b>

\*\*Recipients of the Chancellor's Award cannot simultaneously hold a President's Scholarship, FIRST Robotics or a Guaranteed Entrance Scholarship. In addition, you must register as a full-time student in September 2026 and still be enrolled as a full-time student when the award is paid in January 2027. You must accept our Offer of Admission by the expiry date.
