BACHELOR OF EDUCATION ADMISSION - FALL 2026

Please check Important Documents in WebAdvisor to verify that we receive all required documentation by the applicable deadline. Failure to check "MyNipissing" could affect the status of your offer of admission. Please use this form as your checklist.

IMPORTANT DATES

MARCH 9, 2026

- **Deadline to accept your offer of admission** – Indicate your response through the Ontario Universities' Application Centre (OUAC) website at www.ouac.on.ca/teas. You will require your OUAC username and password. **Late responses will not be accepted.**
- **Practicum Registration Form due.** Failure to provide the required documentation by the deadline will result in a \$75 late fee and possible cancellation of the practicum. Use the following link for additional information and to access this form:

MAY 1, 2026

- **Apply for your Police Vulnerable Sector Check (PVSC) now.** The process to obtain a PVSC can take up to 6 months when police services are receiving a high volume of requests (which is common at the beginning of a new academic year). **A PVSC issued prior to May 1, 2026, will not be accepted.** Failure to submit an acceptable PVSC by 4:30 p.m. on September 14, 2026, will result in a \$75 late fee and the cancellation of your practicum. **Use the following link for additional information:** www.nipissingu.ca/bedofferchecklist.

JUNE 1, 2026

- **Non-refundable admission deposit of \$500.00 due.** Payment can be made through online banking or PayMyTuition. Payment can also be made by cheque or money order mailed to the University.

JUNE 30, 2026

- **Final transcript due.** If you received a conditional offer of admission, you must submit a final transcript that shows your degree has been conferred and all required courses are completed. Transcripts from Ontario universities must be ordered through OUAC. You must contact your university directly for all transcripts from outside Ontario. Nipissing students do not need to order a Nipissing transcript.
- **Legal proof of name change due.** If documents received reflect a different name than your current name (unless previously provided upon application) you must submit an acceptable document to show proof of name change.

MID JULY 2026

- **You will gain access to your Nipissing email.** From this point on, we will communicate with you only through your Nipissing email account.

EARLY AUGUST 2026

- **Registration information** will be emailed to your Nipissing email account. All students entering the Consecutive Bachelor of Education program will be registered in all their required courses by the Office of the Registrar. An email will be sent to you in early August including information about your timetable, parking, tuition fees, textbooks, student accessibility services, financial aid, scholarships, bursaries and awards, meal plans, athletics, and student union.

SEPTEMBER 14, 2026

- **Police Vulnerable Sector Check due by 4:30pm.** Failure to provide an acceptable PVSC by the deadline will result in a \$75 late fee and the possible cancellation of your practicum.
- **Health & Safety and Concussion training certificates are due by 4:30pm.** Failure to provide all documents will result in a \$75 late fee (per document) and the possible cancellation of your practicum.
