Depending on my approved accommodations, I may use one or more of the following technologies:

- **Word Processor, and Spelling and Grammar Check:** Microsoft Word.
- **Text-to-Speech:** Read&Write and OrbitNote.
- **Voice-to-Text:** Microsoft Dictate.
- **Calculators:** Approved calculators are permitted with testing environment restrictions.
- **Noise-Cancelling Headsets:** Noise-cancelling headsets or headphones, provided they are not paired or connected to another device during testing.
- **Allergy and Medical Alert Technology:** Personal devices and technology required for health, allergy, or medical alerts.
- **Note-Taking:** Jamworks.
- **Content Capture by Alternate Means:** Jamworks and local recording devices.
- **Digital Recording:** Local recording devices
- **Laptop or Tablet Access:** Personal laptops and tablets.
- **FM System/Assistive Listening Technology:** Personal FM systems
- **Digital Textbooks and Readings:** Accessible digital-format textbooks, course readings, and related instructional materials.
